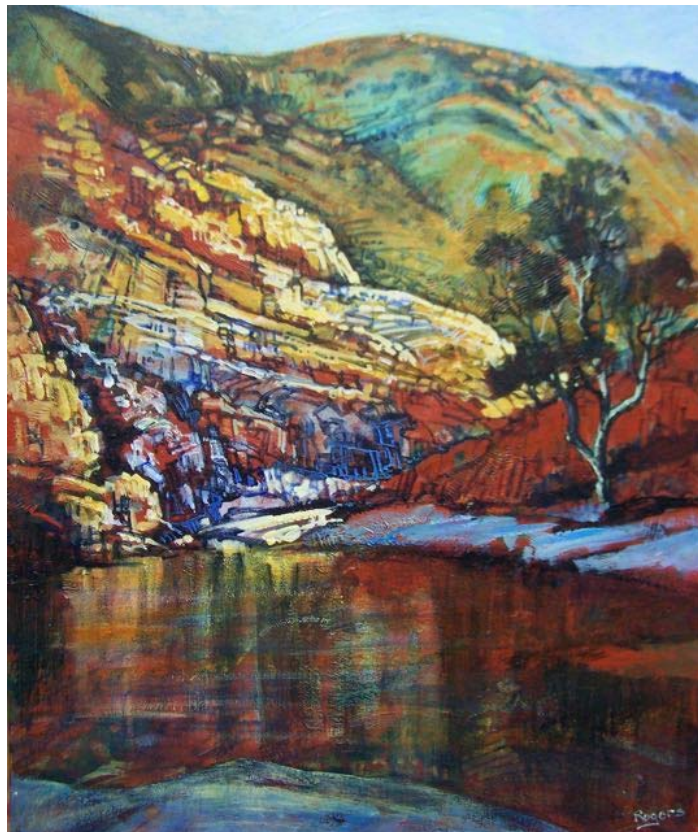


Figure 1 Ormiston Gorge Tjoritja / West MacDonnell National Park, Northern Territory

- four key colour concepts to guide colour choices and colour mixing.

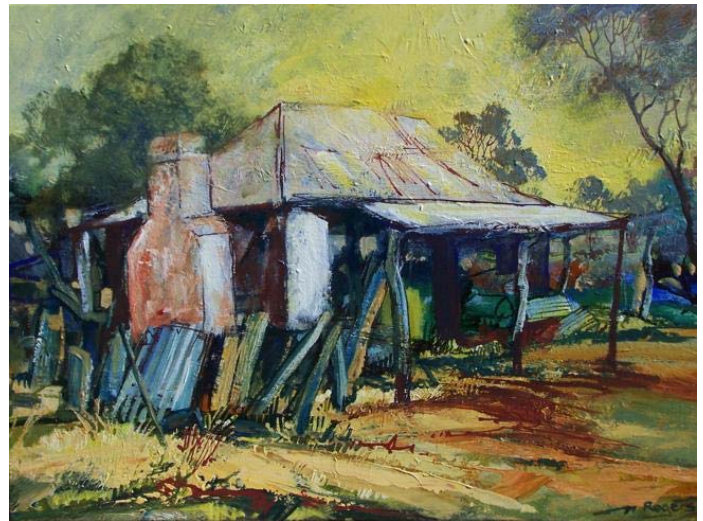


Figure 2 Settlers cottage, Blinman
